

New Graduation Regulations Information

Graduation rates will be based on a Four-year Adjusted Cohort, The new regulations tighten up the requirements needed to remove a student from the Cohort, withdraw a student and not have them count against your graduation rate. To remove a student, a school or district must confirm in writing that a student has transferred out, or emigrated to another country, or is deceased. For students who transfer out of a school, the written confirmation must be official and document that the student has enrolled in another school or in an educational program that culminates in a regular high school diploma.

Effective 2009-2010, next year, the notification letter to eligible students in districts that must offer Public School Choice (PSC) or Supplemental Educational Services (SES) is to be sent out no later than 14 days before the start of school.
